

“Date Night on Us” Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The “Promoter” of Nicholas Street Precinct, Date Night on Us (the “Competition”) is the Ipswich City Council (“the Promoter”),
ABN 61 461 981 077, of 1 Nicholas Street, Ipswich 4305.
2. Information on how to enter the Nicholas Street Precinct – “Dinner on Us” (the “**Competition**”) forms part of the terms and conditions of entry.
3. Entrants into Nicholas Street Precinct – “Date Night on Us” Competition will be deemed as having read the full terms and conditions before entry and as having accepted these terms and conditions.
4. Entry to the competition is open to people over the age of 18 years old. An entrant to the Competition must be an individual and not a company or organisation. Employees of the Promoter or any person associated with the Competition, or any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize(s) are not eligible to enter.
5. Each entry must be entered in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter may at their discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

The decision of the Promoter to accept and reject an entry is final. No correspondence will be entered into. Ten (10) Winners will be drawn on Friday 27th February 2026 at 10am. Each winner receiving Date Night vouchers to the value of \$200.
